Tournament Conditions:

Registration: Please produce your current club membership card, or phone app ID, at registration to verify you are a financial member of your club.

Format: 24 pairs to play in six sections of four pairs - top two from each section to qualify (12 pairs).

Section play: Best of three frames, scores to be recorded on result sheet.

Post-section Championship (best of three frames through to final of five frames):
12 qualifiers - top four pairs have byes into quarterfinals.

Flight (non-qualifiers from Championship):
Four pairs play semifinals and final - best of three frames.

Plate (non-qualifiers from Section Play):
12 pairs - top four pairs have byes into quarterfinals. Four remaining pairs play for quarterfinal places (one frame), then semifinals and final are best of three frames.

Consolation Plate (non-qualifiers from Plate):
Four pairs play semifinals and then final (one-frame).

Dress Code: Dress trousers, plain-coloured long-sleeve dress shirt fastened at the wrists, bow or neck tie, and dress shoes must be worn during all tournament play. Waistcoat is optional. Eye shades may be worn, but no other form of headgear will be allowed. NOT ACCEPTABLE – jeans, tracksuits, jandals, sandals, sneakers, slippers, beachwear, roll neck pull overs, and T-shirts.

Rules: For this tournament, the foul and miss rule will be played as follows: If you are unable to hit the ball on, a foul and miss will be called, your opponent has three options: play from where it is, make you play from where it is, or replace the balls and you play again. Your opponent may replace the balls and make you play again TWICE (2 times). On the third miss, your opponent has two options: play from where it is, or make you play from where it is.

Snookers: During Section Play, Flight, Plate and Consolation Plate, if you require 4 or more snookers to win, with only the colours remaining on the table, the match is over. This does not apply to the main event. Remaining points to be split between the two pairs, with any extra point going to the winning pair.

Last ball: The first pair on the Black gets one shot, unless both pairs require the black to win or draw.

Reminder: This is pairs, you may talk to your partner before you go to the table, but must not talk again until your turn is finished. Your partner is not allowed to approach the table.

IMPORTANT - PLEASE NOTE:

This tournament has banned the use of mobile phones for receiving, calling or texting during the playing of a match. The penalty for ALL Snooker Matches will be LOSS OF FRAME.

Main event, semifinals; best of 3 frames.

Plate final; best of 3 frames.

Flight final; best of 3 frames.

Main event, final. Best of 5 frames.
